

MAKANI OLU also provides a low impact venue for conducting scientific and cultural observations to protected locations, such as marine sanctuaries and remote Pacific Islands — *at a more reasonable cost than many other vessels*. The ship provides lodging for up to 14; meals are provided and there is space for equipment. MAKANI OLU has also served as a safety escort for other vessels.

5-Day Three Island Experience

This 5 day, 4 island sailing adventure lets you explore around the islands of Laanā`i, Maui, Moloka`i and O`ahu. Snorkel in the pristine waters at remote areas of Lana`i and Maui. Enjoy the historic seaport of Lahaina and then set sail for the splendor of the North Shore of Moloka`i. There's plenty of time for land excursions, too.



Sample itinerary:

- Day 1: Depart Kāne'ohe Bay at 8:00 a.m. Sail to Lana`i Is.
- Day 2: Snorkel at Needles; sail to Molokini.
- Day 3: Snorkel Molokini, evening in Lahaina.
- Day 4: Sail the North Coast of Moloka`i, Anchor off Papohaku or Kalaupapa.
- Day 5: Sail from Moloka`i to Kāne'ohe at 4 p.m.

Price: Starting at \$3,500 per night for up to 14 passengers, with meals (depending on route, meals, and group interests).

Half Day Sails

Navigate, steer and chart your course on a four hour sail in panoramic Kāne'ohe Bay. Enjoy lunch and a swim at the sandbar, or a beautiful sunset.



Full Day Sails

Chart your own course on the Windward side of O`ahu from Kahalu`u to Makapu`u Point. This open ocean blue water adventure includes trolling, swimming and schooner games. Or mix business activities with experiential learning, team games, and recreation in an unforgettable day of adventure at sea.



Half Day Sails: Three hour sail (morning or afternoon).
Price: Starting at \$1,000 for up to 20 passengers.

Full Day Sails: Six hour Windward O`ahu sail.
Price: Starting at \$1,500 for up to 20 passengers.

2 1/2-Day Moloka`i & Lana`i Weekender

Experience the splendor of Moloka`i and sail along her remote North Shore. This weekend sailing adventure will leave you breathless. Learn to sail a tall ship; complete with terminology, navigation, knots, steering, bow watch and reading the wind. Visit Kaunakakai and enjoy the beauty of Kalaupapa, Wailau, or Halawa Valleys. See the world's tallest sea cliffs with cascading waterfalls.



3-Day Kaua`i Experience

Cross the Kaua`i Channel and sail the famous Napali Coast with its beautiful waterfalls and sea caves. Pass the Forbidden Island of Ni`ihau. Experience beautiful sunsets, night skies and sunrises. Enjoy views of lush green valleys and spend an evening at lively Nawiliwili.
