
- Day 1: Depart Kāne'ohe Bay at 8:00 a.m.
Sail to the Island of Lana`i.
- Day 2: Snorkel at Needles; sail to Molokini.
- Day 3: Snorkel Molokini, spend the evening in Lahaina, depart at 9 p.m.
- Day 4: Sail the North Coast of Moloka`i, Anchor off Papohaku or Kalaupapa.
- Day 5: Sail the North Shore of Moloka`i.
Back ashore at Kāne'ohe Bay at 4 p.m.

3-Day Kaua`i Experience

Chart your course for the Garden Island of Kaua`i. Cross the Kaua`i channel and sail the famous Napali Coast. - Day 3: Return across the Kaua`i Channel (or fly home). Back ashore at Kāne'ohe Bay at 4 p.m.


Half Day Sails: Up to four hour sail (morning or afternoon). Enjoy panoramic views, swimming, sailing and refreshments.
